

## 2016-17 Foundation Awards – District 7600

**Citation for Meritorious Service** - is provided to only one Rotarian in each District per year for exemplary and significant service to The Rotary Foundation. This award may be received only once and less than 200 Rotarians are honored each year. Because the Foundation has other means of recognizing significant financial support, those providing only monetary gifts are not eligible for this award.

District Total Giving = \$791.292 (new District Record)
District PolioPlus Contributions = \$119,006 + \$27,000 DDF = \$146,006

**100% Every Rotarian Every Year Club:** Qualification - For clubs that achieve 100% participation (EREY) and the club must have US\$100 or more in Per Capita giving to the Annual Fund. District 7600 had **20** Rotary Clubs attain 100% EREY.
